We would like you to consider the following points taken from the Highway Code before leaving your car parked on the road or grass verge

Are you parking your car:

- near a school entrance or where children may run out
- anywhere you would prevent access for Emergency Services
- at or near a bus stop
- on the approach to a Pedestrian crossing
- opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction.
- opposite a traffic island or another parked vehicle
- where you would force other traffic to enter a bus or cycle lane
- where the kerb has been lowered to help wheelchair users and powered mobility vehicles
- in front of, or opposite an entrance to a property where you would restrict access
- on a bend
- where you would obstruct cyclists' use of cycle facilities
- Parking on the pavement which can obstruct pedestrians, people in wheelchairs or with visual impairments and people with prams or pushchairs.

If any of these points apply to your choice of parking place, please reconsider and look for a more suitable place.
