- A seat for the bus shelter in Church Road, has been ordered in the sum of £148. We are waiting confirmation of delivery/installation date
- Cory In-Vessel impact response from Traffic Committee has been sent to GCC. Cllr Habgood had attended the planning meeting regarding this matter on behalf of the Parish Council
- Street Lighting response. After consideration it was agreed that the Committee felt that Bishops Cleeve did not meet the criteria for the Street Lighting reduction programme and the Clerk was instructed to respond accordingly

- TBC have emailed to state that no further action will be taken regarding a raised manhole cover in Furlong Lane
- Confirmation has been received from GCC that the path way leading to the Utility Compound next to St Michaels Court has not been adopted and therefore does not belong to GCC.
- Notification of the termination of Bus Route L has been received

- Best Value Working party has requested that the Traffic Committee consider putting notice boards up inside some bus shelters. After discussion it was agreed that Best Value Working group would agree location and design on a trial basis.

- Notice of graffiti on a bus shelter on by-pass has been received. Clerk had investigated but could not find any evidence.
- Homelands Farm development. Cllr Taylor updated the Traffic Committee on the matter as any development would have an impact on the volume of traffic in the area.
- Cable ties are being used to tie notices to lamp posts and could cause injury.
