## **2 Minutes of the Meeting of 17<sup>th</sup> November 2000.**

## **2 Matters Arising.**

The bus shelter at Cleeve School has not been replaced as yet. Clerk to chase.

## **4 Chairs Update.**

Cllr Rawlings updated Members as follows:-

- Footpath - The additional money sought by Grimshaw Kinear has been cut from approximately £300 to £150 after negotiation.
- No Right Turn from Car Park - Meeting held with GCC, TBC, and Police and consensus was to remove signs as any other course of action was considered impractical.
- Potholes at Entrance to Car park Opposite Nat West Bank - Borough Council are to approach Tesco for a contribution to effect a permanent repair.
- Bus Shelter Gotherington Lane - Vandalism repaired, a new roof has been fitted at a cost of £650.
- Sandown Road Junction – Report re correspondence with resident by GCC. Resident suggested roundabout and buying part of the garden of adjacent property to set wall back. Martyn Midgley had advised that this was not a practical solution and explained the “thinking” behind the current solution.

## **5 Members Reports**

Cllr Richmond mentioned a number of matters:

- He will follow up on the car park repairs mentioned above.
- Continuing his Road safety work with speed gun and has been talking to police etc.
- Grundon MRF approved – He is considering whether or not a Judicial review could be requested by the Council on the basis that County Councillors did not have an important Halcrow report regarding traffic.

## **6 Any Other Business**

Cllr P. Lightfoot indicated that the new footpath was a great improvement and looked good.

Cllr A. Lightfoot asked if there were any notices to put up regarding the new bus pass system and it was agreed that Cllr Richmond was get some from the Borough Council.
